WHAT IS A RETROFIT DESIGNER?

Retrofit Designers play a pivotal role in the UK's efforts to decarbonise its housing stock. Central to PAS 2035, qualified Retrofit Designers provide the required expertise to specify and design safe and suitable energy efficiency improvements to existing buildings.

The British Standard BSI PAS 2035 requires a suitably qualified design professional to be involved in every project. It also stipulates that qualified architects, construction managers or surveyors should fulfil the Retrofit Designer role on most projects. Retrofit Designers are the professionals with core design skills and the knowledge of retrofit required to undertake this role to the required standard.

2 years' post-qualification experience in architecture, surveying, or construction management.
