COMING SOON - UNDERSTANDING NON-DOMESTIC RETROFIT

Understanding Non-Domestic Retrofit is an online course that offers best practices for decarbonising non-domestic buildings like schools, hospitals, and commercial properties, which contribute 23% of the UK's carbon emissions. The Hub is home to a range of unique content, events and community discussion forums that are essential to supporting continued professional development and lifelong learning.








